CHURCH ADMINISTRATOR NOMINATIONS

This position was created by Church Council about 18 months ago just as we were entering our first lockdown. Peter Robinson is the current Church Administrator and the role is for 12 months as with all other Church Council positions. The role is one of being the first person of contact from outside individuals, organisations and govt that require a response from us and it was created to help us fill some of the duties previously undertaken by the minister. Whether it is someone who phoned looking for an historic connection with our church, to responses to Government surveys and form filling in. Church members might contact the Administrator to list their name on the WWC, working with children, register or seek direction on planning a church wide activity.

CHURCH COUNCIL NEWS:

- The house on Kahibah Street (fronting our church) is coming up for sale and Church Council is considering purchase. This would be a major undertaking and a major financial commitment, but it was agreed it should be seriously considered.
- The National Church Life Survey which normally takes place at the same time as the Australian Census, has been deferred until February, due to Covid issues.

- Westpac Morisset is to close, and the Treasurer is making alternative arrangements to use the Post Office to make deposits.
- Over Advent and Christmas we will again support Christmas Bowl, and also support Uniting World "Everything in Common".
- Lake Mac Church has a rental agreement with us to use our building on Sunday afternoons for their worship services, and Friday afternoons and evening for youth group activities.

LADIES FELLOWSHIP ACTIVITIES:

- The Christmas meeting at 10 am on Tuesday 7th December will be an outing to Market Street Cafe at Wangi. This is open to anyone to come and join us, but please see Val as we have to book numbers.
- A Christmas dinner for all the congregation is being planned for December. More information when we have caterers organised.
- Forward plans include a "Pot Luck Welcome Lunch" after church on 30th January, and in 2022 a re-thinking of the name and purpose of Ladies Fellowship.
